SGTraDex signs MOU with key partners to accelerate digitalisation in the logistics sector

Singapore, **11 July 2023** – A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) calling for Digital Collaboration for Logistics Innovation was penned by key logistics players at the "Conference on Collaborative Data in Supply Chain: The SGTraDex Advantage" event supported by Enterprise Singapore (EnterpriseSG) and the Infocomm Media Development Authority (IMDA).

The MOU was signed by representatives from SGTraDex, PSA Corporation Ltd (PSA), Industry Solution Providers CargoERP, Innosys, Keyfields and Haulio, and Trade Associations CDAS, SLA and STA.

Details of the MOU

The MOU sought to affirm partnership between the industry represented by the Trade Associations, PSA and Industry Solution Providers, to jointly develop and accelerate digital collaboration for the logistics sector with SGTraDex through:

- 1. Fostering a data-driven logistics ecosystem by driving the adoption of digital solutions and data connectivity through SGTraDex.
- 2. Joint outreach to advocate, communicate, and market the initiative to the broader logistics sector.

Specifically, SGTraDex's MOU with PSA called for the joint development of industry tools and applications which will support the larger objective of enhancing trade and supply chain efficiency.

Increased data sharing and interoperability within the logistics sector would improve visibility and traceability in cargo and asset movements.

It would allow better operation forecasting at key logistics nodes such as ports and depots. In addition, cargo carriers such as shipping lines and hauliers could further optimise their schedules and minimise potential delays, enjoying productivity improvements. This would enhance overall efficiency across the supply chain to benefit the ecosystem.

Overcoming challenges in the logistics sector

These MOU terms signify a comprehensive and collaborative approach towards advancing digitalisation and data sharing in the logistics sector. The commitment from the MOU signatories and the facilitation provided by SGTraDex are aimed at



creating a more efficient, interconnected, and standardised supply chain ecosystem. By promoting data exchange, innovation, and collaboration, this partnership will drive positive transformation within the industry, benefiting all stakeholders involved.



Launched on 1 June 2022, the Singapore Trade Data Exchange (SGTraDex) is a digital utility that facilitates the sharing of data between supply chain ecosystem partners, streamlining information flows through a common data highway where data can be shared in a trusted, secure and inclusive manner.

SGTraDex uses proprietary technology anchored through a public-private partnership model to resolve pain points in supply chain ecosystems including a heavy reliance on a paper-based system which lacks efficiency, transparency and sustainability. The move to digitise information will increase productivity and build supply chain resilience.
